



Cascade Irrigation Efficiency

Upgrades to Business and Multifamily Irrigation Systems

Overview

Cascade Water Alliance offers rebates to encourage businesses and multifamily property owners to improve the efficiency of their existing in-ground irrigation systems by installing high efficiency upgrades.

There have been dramatic changes in irrigation hardware technology in recent years allowing customers to greatly minimize water wasted through irrigation. New technologies allow you to match the watering needs of your lawn and garden to current weather conditions, minimize or eliminate watering when it rains and more easily maintain a healthy, attractive landscape.

Cascade members include: Bellevue, Covington Water District, Issaquah, Kirkland, Redmond, Sammamish Plateau Water and Sewer District, Skyway Water and Sewer District and Tukwila.

Eligibility

1. The account must be a water utility customer of a member of Cascade Water Alliance.
2. The irrigation system must be at least two years old.
3. The work must be performed by a licensed irrigation contractor.
4. ET Controllers must be chosen from the Smart Water Application Technology (SWAT) list of tested products. For more information visit www.irrigation.org/smartwater/ia-tested.asp or call (425) 453-1810.
5. Rebates are dependent on available funding and may not exceed 50% of the total cost of the project.

Instructions

1. Verify that your business or property is a customer of a Cascade member.
2. Complete the attached application and submit to Cascade *before* initiating work activities. The request will be reviewed and you will be notified within 2 weeks of Cascade's receipt if the project is approved.
