

## Business and Residential Notice

Distribution Date: August 19, 2010

Portions of Lake Tapps will be treated with the aquatic herbicide(s)/algaecide(s) on/or between August 30th and October 8th. Three applications will be made at approximately two week intervals. The first treatment is planned for Monday August 30th weather permitting.

Product(s) planned for use: Sonar Q and Sonar PR granular

Active ingredient(s): fluridone, no water use restrictions for potable water use, swimming or fishing. There is a irrigation precaution for withdrawals from the treatment area.
