RECOGNITION

WHEREAS, Cascade Water Alliance is an eight-member nonprofit corporation formed in 1999 to provide clean, safe, and reliable water to their almost 400,000 residents and more than 22,000 businesses; and

WHEREAS, Cascade Water Alliance celebrates its tenth anniversary on May 18th, noting its accomplishments over the past decade and unveiling plans for upcoming public outreach on its water transmission and supply planning for the next several decades; and

WHEREAS, members include the cities of Bellevue, Redmond, Issaquah, Kirkland and Tukwila; Covington Water District, Sammamish Plateau Water and Sewer District, and Skyway Water District; and

WHEREAS, Cascade has successfully met its initial mission of ensuring the availability of clean, safe, water for east and south King County communities; and

WHEREAS Cascade Water Alliance has authored historic agreements with the Muckleshoot Indian Tribe and Puyallup Indian Tribe that provide for the protection of fish habitat and stream flows in the White River; and

WHEREAS, Cascade's conservation programs save about half a million gallons of water a day;
